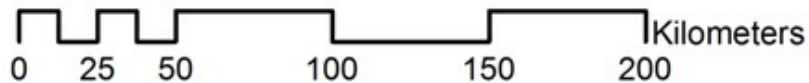

Mean Annual Rainfall State of Hawai'i

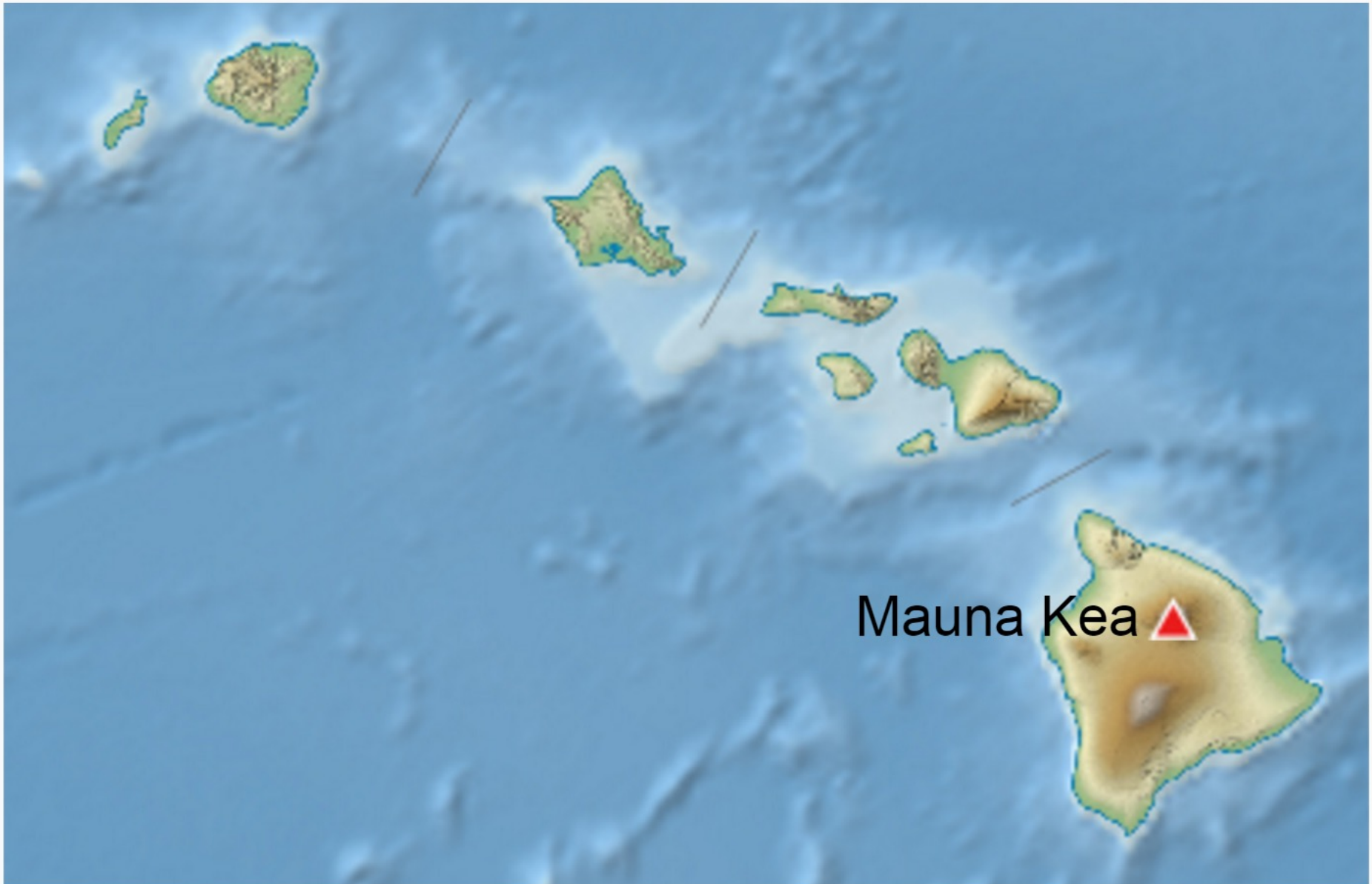

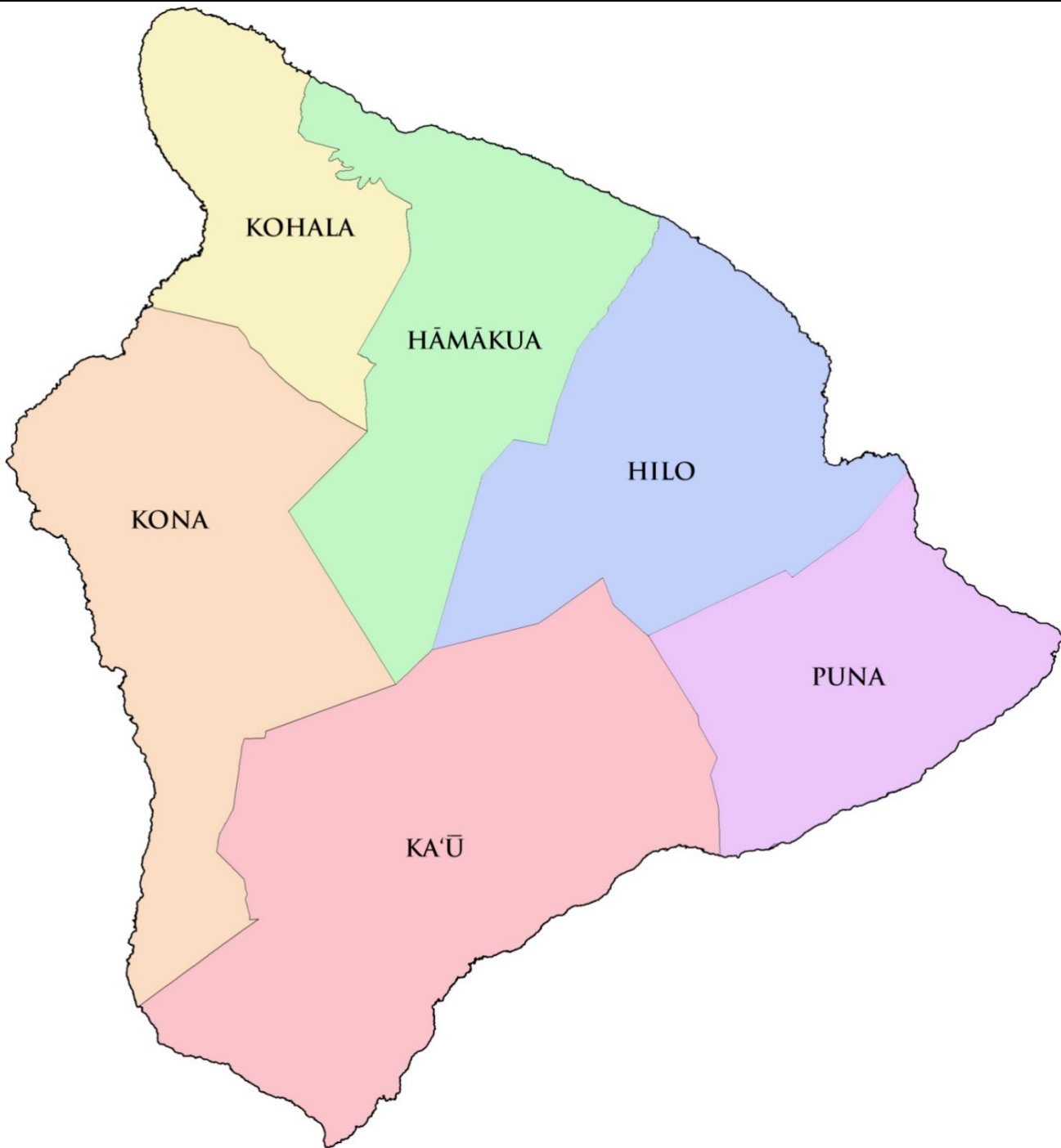

Hashtag Heard ‘Round the World: Social Media Fuels TMT Protests

Supporters of the Thirty Meter Telescope on the Big Island were caught unaware by a frenzy of Facebook, Instagram and Twitter posts.

When Kahookahi Kanuha came up with the hashtag #TMTshutdown, he had no idea how far it would spread.

As of Wednesday afternoon, the hashtag has been used in more than 12,000 photos and videos on Instagram alone. It also peppers Facebook and Twitter statuses calling for a stop to the construction of the Thirty Meter Telescope on Mauna Kea, a mountain on the east side of Hawaii Island that many Native Hawaiians revere as sacred.

It's a distinctly 21st century way of defending age-old traditions, and TMT opponents delighted in the money and support that's come from gaining worldwide attention. It's become trendy to oppose the project, which has been portrayed as a symbol of colonialism and disrespect to Native Hawaiians.

TMT launched its own online campaign Monday, but it seems to be off to a slow start as it seeks to respond to the most widespread concerns and debunk misconceptions about the project.

On This Day: In 1993 the U.S. passed Public Law 103-150, which was an attempt to apologize for the overthrow of the Kingdom of Hawaii. During the late 19th century, wealthy American settlers established large sugar, cattle, and other plantations in the Hawaiian Islands (then known as the Sandwich Islands). When Native Hawaiian supporters of Queen Liliuokalani attempted to confirm their independence through a new constitution in 1893, the settlers responded with a coup, supported by the United States, which quickly annexed the islands. One hundred years later, a resolution of Congress apologized for these events. However, for Native Hawaiians, the apology is not enough, and their demands for sovereignty, self-determination, and the return of the Hawaiian Islands to Native rule continues. — with Keonali Hutley.
